Description	A nail-type fastener with a 3/8" diameter steel washer as an integral part of the nail, approximately 1/3 up the shank of the nail from the point.	
Applications/ Advantages	Used to anchor metal, plastic, wood, particle board or fiber board in concrete, block or brick. It doesn't require a pre-drilled hole and can be set with a hammer when using a setting tool designed for drive pins.	
Material	Heat treated alloy steel	
Anchor Spacing	Anchors should be installed a minimum of ten anchor diameters between each other and a minimum of five anchor diameters from the edge.
